SYNOPSIS

Set in the southern California of the 1990s, The Club is a supernatural action-comedy following Frank Kempe, a privileged young man torn between libertinism and moralism as Lifestyle Coordinator at Tremington Country Club, which, according to his mother's will, he stands to inherit just a month after the film begins.

Yet Frank's father, George, fears that Frank's already extreme spending habits will become totally ruinous once he assumes full control of the club, and he is desperate to prevent the transfer of ownership to Frank.

George is so desperate that he enlists the help of his spiritually questionable guru, Jaegen Nomesh, in a marketing campaign aimed at disinheriting Frank and changing the character of Tremington Country Club forever.

Only Frank and his faithful secretary, Tina, stand in the way.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

The Club tackles some big setups and themes for a short film because it was derived from a feature-length script of the same name and story. The goal with the short was to capture the spirit of that larger piece in as fun and compelling a form as possible.

The trigger to actually make the film was pulled because of a self-imposed deadline, the end of 2021. By November of that year there was still a lot of uncertainty about how freely it would be possible to operate because of intermittent Covid-19 lockdowns, so it was a gamble in mid November to commit to shooting in 4 weeks.

As a consequence of that compressed timeline, pre-production and production were basically fused into one, and for a two-month period straddling 2021 and 2022, the work of writing, casting, location scouting and shooting occurred on an ongoing basis.

In post it became clear that the 36-minute cut was simply too much and that a much shorter cut would be necessary. Thankfully not too many VFX shots had to be eliminated, but there were dramatic changes, obviously. The result is, hopefully, a film that's both entertaining in itself and that points to larger possibilities for the world it builds. Thanks for watching!

TOM LONGANO AS FRANK KEMPE

A native of Washington, D.C., Tom moved to Los Angeles four years ago with the broad goal of working in entertainment. Since then he has been welcomed into the legal departments of notable production companies, produced stand-up and sketch comedy shows, published books of children's stories, and landed commercial gigs. In 2019, he attended a free acting class he came across online and never looked back.

Los Angeles based Actress, Nicole Mattox, grew up in a suburb of San Antonio, Texas. After graduating college, she moved to Los Angeles and has taken on a variety of roles in short films, television series, feature films and social media shows since beginning her professional acting career in 2021. In 2021 she began studying at the prestigious acting school of "Playhouse West" under the instruction of co-founder/owner Robert Carnegie, and well-known acting coach Holly Gagnier.
